The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board is responsible for regulating pipelines in the province that carry hazardous materials.

The Board's Pipeline Safety staff has conducted an investigation related to a butane leak from a pipeline on Bayside Drive in Saint John on January 8, 2018.

The pipeline is licenced to Irving Oil Terminals and Pipelines, G.P.

Following the incident engineers from the Board contacted the company and began an investigation.
