Schedule for Changes to Maximum Prices April 1, 2019

The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) wishes to remind petroleum wholesalers that Bill 11, currently before the New Brunswick Legislature, will amend the *Petroleum Products Pricing Act* (PPPA) to include federal fuel charge rates into the maximum allowable petroleum prices set by the Board. The amendments will come into force on April 1, 2019.

The Board will set new maximum petroleum prices, effective April 1, 2019, to include the fuel charge rates.

The federal fuel charge rates, effective April 1, 2019, will be:

Gasoline:	4.42 cents per litre
Ultra-low sulphur diesel:	5.37 cents per litre
Furnace Oil:	5.37 cents per litre, and
Propane:	3.10 cents per litre

HST is applicable to the fuel charge rates and will be included in the new maximum petroleum prices.

The Board will issue new maximum prices to wholesalers on Friday March 29, 2019, in order to ensure proper distribution of the price changes before they come into effect at 12:01 AM, Monday April 1, 2019.

As always, in accordance with section 3(4) of the PPPA, wholesalers are to ensure that any retailers to whom they sell petroleum products are informed of any changes to maximum prices before they come into effect.
