## NOTICE

**The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board** (Board) is authorized to monitor and assess compliance with approved reliability standards pursuant to section 122 of the *Electricity Act*, S.N.B. 2013, c. 7, the *Reliability Standards Regulation - Electricity Act*, N.B. Reg. 2013-66 (Regulation) and Schedule “A” to the Regulation, being the New Brunswick Compliance Monitoring and Enforcement Program (NBCMEP).

The Board is required, pursuant to the NBCMEP, to develop an **Annual Implementation Plan** that identifies:

- Approved Reliability Standards that will be actively monitored during the coming year;
- The methods to be used by the Board for monitoring compliance with each Approved Reliability Standard; and
- The Annual Audit Plan.

On Thursday, November 19, 2020, the Board approved a draft Annual Implementation Plan for 2021. This draft Annual Implementation Plan is now available on the Board's website at [www.nbeub.ca](http://www.nbeub.ca) under Matter No. 482.

The final Annual Implementation Plan will be posted on the Board's website and will be effective January 1, 2021.
