NOTICE OF APPLICATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Irving Oil Marketing G.P. and Irving Oil Commercial G.P. (collectively referred to as Irving Oil) have applied to the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) on January 5, 2021 for:

1. An interim order under section 40 of the *Energy and Utilities Board Act* (Act) approving an immediate, non-rebatable interim increase of \$0.035 per litre in wholesale margins for motor fuels and furnace oil;
2. A final order approving an increase in wholesale margin for motor fuels from \$0.0651 per litre to \$0.1064 per litre;
3. A final order approving an increase in wholesale margin for furnace oil from \$0.055 per litre to \$0.0963 per litre; and
4. Such further order, decision, and/or direction with respect to any other matters, as the Board deems necessary.

The Board will conduct a pre-hearing conference via the Zoom Web Conference platform on **January 25, 2021, beginning at 9:30 a.m.**, at which time the Board will consider the following issues:

- a. Minimum Filing Requirements;
- b. The specific process that will be used by the Board to consider this application;
- c. An appropriate filing schedule;
- d. Intervener Requests;
- e. Irving Oil's request for an interim order under section 40 of the Act, including any written or oral submission of approved Interveners relevant to this request; and
- f. Any other relevant issue.

Parties who intend to intervene should register by visiting the Rules of Procedure section of the Board's website at www.nbeub.ca and complete the "Intervener Request" form, specifying Matter No. 486. The form should be completed and filed with the Board no later

than Thursday, January 21, 2021, at general@nbeub.ca or by calling 1-866-766-2782. Parties are to indicate the official language in which they wish to be heard.
