Matter 485 – Retail Petroleum Margin Review

The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) received a Notice of Motion on January 28, 2021 from the Oil Heat Association of New Brunswick (OHA) requesting a \$0.02 per litre rebatable interim increase in the furnace oil retail margin.

The Board held a hearing to hear the motion on February 11.

Having considered the Board's enabling legislation; the principles established in Matters 307 in deciding whether to make an interim order; the letter dated January 27 filed by the OHA in support of its motion; and the oral submissions by the parties; the Board concludes that the OHA's motion does not meet the established principles for an interim order.
