



PARTIAL DECISION


IN THE MATTER OF an application by Liberty Utilities (Gas New Brunswick) LP, as represented by its general partner Liberty Utilities (Gas New Brunswick) Corp., for an Order approving a new rate schedule designated as its Large Industrial Contract Service Rate Class and approving the Large Industrial Contract Service rate for Atlantic Wallboard Limited Partnership.

(Matter No. 515)

- [1] This partial decision concerns an application by Liberty Utilities (Gas New Brunswick) LP, as represented by its general partner, Liberty Utilities (Gas New Brunswick) Corp. (Liberty).
- [2] Liberty applied to the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) on December 23, 2021 for approval of a new rate schedule, designated as its Large Industrial Contract Service (LICS) Rate Class, and for approval of an LICS rate for Atlantic Wallboard Limited Partnership (AWL).
- [3] This partial decision is being rendered to enable Liberty to start planning for the connection of AWL to the gas distribution system in a timely fashion. The Board will issue its final decision with reasons at a later date. If there is any difference between the final decision and this partial decision, the final decision shall govern.
- [4] Having reviewed the evidence filed in connection with this matter and considered the submissions from all of the parties, the Board approves:
- a. The LICS Rate Class as set out in Liberty’s Revised Schedule A, dated April 1, 2022, subject to the revision of the first sentence in the Applicability section as follows: “Large Industrial Contract Service (LICS) Rate is applied to any applicant that meets the requirements of this rate schedule and was not connected to Liberty’s Distribution System at the time of becoming an LICS customer.”; and
 - b. The LICS rates and minimum annual charge for AWL, as set out in the Confidential Attachment No. 1, in Schedule A of Liberty’s LICS Evidence dated December 23, 2021.
- [5] These rates and charge will be effective upon the written confirmation to the Board that AWL has been connected to the gas distribution system.
