The **New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board** will conduct a review of outstanding issues pertaining to the methodology of calculation and settlement of lost and unaccounted for gas, as outlined in a letter to parties, dated November 25, 2021, following the conclusion of Matter 508;

The Board engaged an independent consultant to facilitate a working group of stakeholders to review the current methodology and prepare a recommendation to the Board for approval (Report). The consultant recommended that the Proposed Questions set out in the report be posed to Liberty Utilities (Gas New Brunswick) LP, as represented by Liberty Utilities (Gas New Brunswick) Corp. (Liberty) for written response.

The Board has ordered Liberty to prepare the written responses to the Proposed Questions set out in the Report by Friday, June 10, at 4:00 p.m.

The Board will conduct a pre-hearing conference for this Matter via Zoom Video Conference on Tuesday, June 14, at 9 a.m. (Atlantic Time). Interested parties may attend and make representations about the procedure to be followed and any other relevant matters
