### **Review of Maximum Retail Margins, Maximum Delivery Costs and Maximum Full Service Charge for Motor Fuels and Furnace Oil**

The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) will conduct a public hearing, pursuant to subsection 14(1) of the *Petroleum Products Pricing Act*, S.N.B. 2006, c. P-8.05 to review the following issues:

1. Maximum retail margins for motor fuels and furnace oil retailers;
2. Maximum delivery costs that can be charged for motor fuels and furnace oil; and
3. The maximum full service charge that can be charged by retailers for motor fuels

to ensure that they are justified, and may order such margins, costs or charge to be adjusted after the review is completed.

The Board retained Gardner Pinfold Consultants Inc. to review the current margins, delivery costs and full service charge, and a report on their findings was provided to the Board. A copy of its report, in both English and French, has been posted on the Board's website.

The Board will conduct a pre-hearing conference for this Matter via Zoom Video Conference on Tuesday, June 28 at 1 p.m. (Atlantic Time). Interested parties may attend and make representations about the procedure to be followed and any other relevant matters
