

NEW BRUNSWICK ENERGY AND UTILITIES BOARD

IN THE MATTER OF a review of maximum retail margins, maximum delivery costs, and maximum full service charge for motor fuels and furnace oil.

ORDER

WHEREAS the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) will conduct a public hearing pursuant to subsection 14(1) of the *Petroleum Products Pricing Act*, S.N.B. 2006, c. P-8.05 (Act) to review the following issues:

1. Maximum retail margins for motor fuels and furnace oil retailers;
2. Maximum delivery costs that can be charged for motor fuels and furnace oil; and
3. The maximum full service charge that can be charged by retailers for motor fuels

to ensure that they are justified, and may order such margins, costs or charge to be adjusted after the review is completed;

AND WHEREAS the Board retained Gardner Pinfold Consultants Inc. to review the current margins, delivery costs and full service charge, and a report on its findings was provided to the Board;

AND WHEREAS a copy of the report, in both English and French, has been posted on the Board's website.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Any information provided by retailers to Gardner Pinfold Consultants Inc. in this matter will be considered confidential by the Board pursuant to section 16 of the Act.
