APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF RATES, ROUTES AND SCHEDULES

NOTICE

The Acadian Peninsula Regional Service Commission (APRSC) has applied to the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) for approval to provide a scheduled public motor bus service from Caraquet to Shippagan and return, with the right to pick up and drop off passengers. The APRSC is also requesting that the Board approve a zero-dollar fare to be charged to passengers throughout the duration of its pilot project.

The Board granted the APRSC a public motor bus licence on March 7, 2023, at which time it determined that a public hearing to consider fares, routes and schedules would be held.

The above-mentioned application and supporting documents may be viewed on the Board's website at www.nbeub.ca under Matter 546.

The Board initially set a hearing date of Tuesday, May 23 for this Matter. There is a need to reschedule the hearing date. The Board is now setting **Monday, May 29, 2023, beginning at 1:30 p.m.** as the hearing date for this Matter, by video conferencing. Interested parties may attend and make representations about the Application. Guidelines for the video conferencing will be provided to all parties prior to the scheduled hearing.

The form should be completed and filed with the Board no later than Friday, May 19, 2023, at general@nbeub.ca. Parties are to indicate the official language in which they wish to be heard.
