Petroleum Pricing Notice and the Removal of Federal Fuel Charge on Furnace Oil

On October 26, 2023, the Government of Canada announced that it will be temporarily pausing the fuel charge on deliveries of home heating oil for a period of three years, effective November 9, 2023, in all provinces and territories where it currently applies. The Government of Canada has posted draft regulations in this regard. Finance Canada has advised that the Canada Revenue Agency will be administering the measures on a provisional basis.

Consequently, the Board will, on a provisional basis, and until it directs otherwise, update the weekly pricing model to exclude the federal fuel charge on furnace oil and adjust the maximum price accordingly.

The maximum price reflecting this change for furnace oil will be effective as of 12:01 a.m., Friday, November 17, 2023.
