NOTICE

Review of Maximum Retail Margins, Maximum Delivery Costs and Maximum Full Service Charge for Motor Fuels and Furnace Oil

The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board will conduct a public hearing, pursuant to subsection 14(1) of the *Petroleum Products Pricing Act* to review the following:

1. maximum retail margins for motor fuels and furnace oil retailers;
2. maximum delivery costs that can be charged for motor fuels and furnace oil; and
3. maximum full-service charge that can be charged by retailers for motor fuels

to ensure that they are justified, and may order such margins, costs or charges to be adjusted after the review is completed.

The Board retained Gardner Pinfold Consultants Inc. to review the current margins, delivery costs and full-service charge, and a report on their findings will be provided to the Board. A copy of Gardner Pinfold's report, in both English and French, will be posted on the Board's website by **Friday, May 9, 2025**.

The Board will hold a pre-hearing conference on this matter via the Zoom videoconference platform on **Tuesday, May 13, 2025 beginning at 9:30 a.m.** Interested parties may attend and make representations about the procedure to be followed.

There, parties will find an "Intervener Request" form.
