## **New Brunswick Power Corporation**

### **Potential Application pursuant to s. 107 of the *Electricity Act* in Relation to the Renewables Integration and Grid Security (“RIGS”) Project**

## **NOTICE**

On July 24, 2025 the New Brunswick Power Corporation has, among other things, filed with the Board a Notice of Motion seeking an Order from the Board declaring that a certain Tolling Agreement entered between NB Power and RIGS Energy Atlantic Limited Partnership, as represented by its general Partner 1542987 B.C. Ltd., dated and effective July 2, 2025 is not a capital project within the meaning of that term as used in subsection 107(1) of the *Electricity Act*, and that the Board does not possess jurisdiction with respect to the Tolling Agreement under section 107 of the *Act* (the “*Motion*”), as well as directions from the Board with respect to the hearing of the said Motion.

NB Power’s Notice of Motion as well as the affidavit evidence and a Claim for Confidentiality filed in support may be viewed on the Board’s website at [www.nbeub.ca](http://www.nbeub.ca) under Matter EL-002-2025. NB Power has also been directed to post copies of its complete public filing with the Board on its website for public review.

The Board issued the following directions to NB Power with respect to the hearing of the Motion and advises the public and any interested parties of same:

1. Anyone who wishes to respond to the Motion must file with the Board by email at [general@nbeub.ca](mailto:general@nbeub.ca) and serve NB Power by email at [NBPReregulatory@nbpower.com](mailto:NBPReregulatory@nbpower.com) a written response outlining their position on the Motion and the grounds for same no later than **Monday, August 11, 2025 at 4:00 p.m.**

2. Anyone who files and serves a written response who also wishes to object to NB Power's claim for confidential treatment of portions of its evidence filed in support of its motion as set out in NB Power's Claim for Confidentiality filed with the Board on July 24, 2025 must also file a written objection in accordance with Rule 6.4 of the Board's *Rules of Procedure* setting out the reasons for their objection(s) no later than **Monday, August 11, 2025 at 4:00 p.m.**
3. Subject to further direction from the Board in the interim, the hearing of the Motion will be held in person in the Hearing Room on the Board's premises in Saint John. The Board has set aside **Wednesday, September 3, 2025** or **Friday, September 5, 2025** as potential dates to hear the Motion.
4. The Board will hold a Case Management Conference on **Tuesday, August 12, 2025 at 2:00 p.m.** via the zoom videoconferencing platform with NB Power and any parties who have filed a written response to the Motion to confirm the date of the hearing and set a schedule for the determination of NB Power's claim for confidentiality, the filing of any affidavit evidence in response, the filing of the written arguments and any other related pre-hearing matters.
