ORDER

WHEREAS:

- 1. The within matter involves a review of the Board's methodology used to determine the cost of carbon adjuster as one of the components used to set motive fuel maximum retail prices pursuant to the *Petroleum Products Pricing Act* with a public hearing scheduled to begin on December 16, 2025;
- 2. as a result of Order-in-Council 2025-187, *An Act Respecting Petroleum Products Pricing*, SNB 2025, c.1, which effectively repeals the provisions in the *Petroleum Products Pricing Act* and the *General Regulation Petroleum Products Pricing Act* which reference the cost of carbon adjustor, comes into effect on December 1, 2025; and
- 3. as a result, the within matter is rendered moot and its continuation is not in the public interest.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The within matter is adjourned sine die.
