## NOTICE

### Changes to Maximum Price Schedule – Christmas/New Year's 2025

The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board sets maximum prices for petroleum products sold in New Brunswick in accordance with the *Petroleum Products Pricing Act*. Pursuant to the *Act* and the *General Regulation – Petroleum Products Pricing Act*, changes to maximum prices come into effect each Friday, with wholesalers receiving notice of the changes the day prior. The legislation also prescribes changes to the schedule in certain circumstances which may occur over the Christmas/New Year's holiday period.

This year, Christmas Day (December 25<sup>th</sup>) and New Year's Day (January 1<sup>st</sup>) both fall on a Thursday. Therefore, in accordance with Section 3 of the *General Regulation*, the Board will notify petroleum wholesalers of new maximum petroleum prices outside of the regular pricing schedule.

**For Christmas week, the Board will set new maximum prices effective Thursday, December 25, 2025.**

**For New Year's week, the Board will set new maximum prices effective Saturday, January 3, 2026.**

**Wholesalers will receive notice of new maximum prices the day prior.**
