NOTICE

The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board has received an application and evidence (**Application**) from the New Brunswick Power Corporation (**NB Power**) pursuant to the *Electricity Act*, S.N.B. 2013, c. 7, and pursuant to *Regulation 2013-66*, being the *Reliability Standards Regulation - Electricity Act* the (**Regulation**), seeking the following relief:

(a) an Order;

- 1) approving modifications of Board approved Reliability Standard IRO-010-5 and NB Appendix IRO-010-5-NB-0 by approving new version IRO-010-6 and NB Appendix IRO-010-6-NB-0;
- 2) approving retirement of existing Board approved Reliability Standard IRO-010-5 and NB Appendix IRO-010-5-NB-0;
- 3) approving modifications of Board approved Reliability Standard MOD-026-1 and NB Appendix MOD-026-1-NB-0 by approving new version MOD-026-2 and NB Appendix MOD-026-2-NB-0;
- 4) approving retirement of existing Board approved Reliability Standard MOD-026-1 and NB Appendix MOD-026-1-NB-0;
- 5) approving retirement of existing Board approved Reliability Standard MOD-027-1 and NB Appendix MOD-027-1-NB-0;
- 6) approving modifications of Board approved Reliability Standard MOD-032-1 and NB Appendix MOD-032-1-NB-0 by approving new version MOD-032-2 and NB Appendix MOD-032-2-NB-0;
- 7) approving retirement of existing Board approved Reliability Standard MOD-032-1 and NB Appendix MOD-032-1-NB-0;
- 8) approving modifications of Board approved Reliability Standard MOD-033-2 and NB Appendix MOD-033-2-NB-0 by approving new version MOD-033-3 and NB Appendix MOD-033-3-NB-0;
- 9) approving retirement of existing Board approved Reliability Standard MOD-033-2 and NB Appendix MOD-033-2-NB-0;

10) approving modifications of Board approved Reliability Standard TOP-003-7 and NB Appendix TOP-003-7-NB-0 by approving new version TOP-003-8 and NB Appendix TOP-003-8-NB-0;

11) approving retirement of existing Board approved Reliability Standard TOP-003-7 and NB Appendix TOP-003-7-NB-0; and

(b) orders and/or directions with respect to such other matters as the Board sees fit.

Pursuant to section 8 of the *Regulation*, the Board shall approve the requested Application if:

(a) modifications recommended by NB Power are not substantively different from the reliability standard as approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission of the United States of America (**FERC**); and

(b) during the comment period, there are no substantive comments received from a registered entity, the standards body or the compliance body; or

(c) modifications recommended by NB Power are not substantively different from revisions approved by FERC to the equivalent reliability standard; and

(d) during the comment period, there are no substantive comments received from a registered entity, the standards body or the compliance body.

Pursuant to section 8 of the *Regulation*, the Board shall retire a reliability standard if:

(a) the application indicates the date on which the FERC approved the retirement of the equivalent standard; and

- (b) during the comment period, there were no substantive comments received from a registered entity, the standards body or the compliance body.

If the requested modifications or comments are substantive, a hearing shall be held by the Board in respect of the Application.
